Dearest Sisters,

Loving and prayerful greetings to each one of you!

On 5 August 2017 we celebrated the 145th anniversary of the Foundation of our Institute. We have a thousand and one reasons to thank God for the wonders and miracles that He accomplishes in our Institute through the powerful mediation of our Bl. Mother who willed our Institute to come into existence. With her motherly presence she accompanies every Daughter of Mary Help of Christians and we are privileged to be part of a Congregation that belongs entirely to Mary and to be a living monument of gratitude of Don Bosco to Mary for all times. The first eleven Sisters who professed on 5 August 1872 were chosen by Don Pestarino keeping in mind the criteria given to him by Don Bosco himself: those who are obedient even in the smallest things; those who are not offended by the corrections received and who have the spirit of mortification. Possessing these characteristics, they gave a sure foundation to our Institute imbued with a deep love for Jesus and for the salvation of the young people. Mother Mazzarello with creativity and feminine intuition reproduced in the first community of Mornese the same environment of Valdocco where one breathed the air of holiness.

Every commemoration of the 5 August is a reminder to each one of us to renew our commitment of fidelity to God and to our Institute walking with the young people towards holiness. From our charismatic origins, let us draw inspiration for today and be efficacious missionaries of hope and joy wherever we are and in whatever we do!

Solemnity of the Assumption of our Bl. Mother and Independence Day

On 1 November 1950, Pope Pius XII solemnly defined the dogma of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven saying, "...the Immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever Virgin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven". Assumption is the crowning of Mary's lifetime, of her vocation, unique among all mankind, to be the Mother of God. It is the crowning of the faith which she, "full of grace" showed during the Annunciation and which Elizabeth so emphasized and extolled during the visitation. As Mary is assumed into heaven, we shall also be assumed into heaven one day if we constantly wage war against sin. The assumption of our Lady reminds us that death is not part of the original plan of God; death came into the world because of sin. Let us therefore fill our lives with good works because on this depends our destiny. Everything will pass away but there will remain the love of God and the love of our neighbor. May Mary our Heavenly and Immaculate

Mother help us to keep our gaze towards heaven as we continue our pilgrim journey on earth!

On this day as we celebrate our Independence from the foreign rule let us invoke God's blessings on our country and its leaders that they may uphold and safeguard the constitutional rights of every citizen. For us as educators of the young people of our country, the coincidence of the spiritual feast and the cultural festival is an apt reminder of the educative goal left to us by Don Bosco of forming 'Good Christians and Honest Citizens' of ourselves and of our youth so as to build a better India for our young generation.

Feast of Blessed Maria Troncatti

Sr. Maria was an authentic Daughter of Mary Help of Christians, a true witness to God's love for the poor, right up to the hour of her tragic death in a plane accident on 25 August 1969. Maria Troncatti the heroic missionary of the Kivaros faced up to situations which were extremely difficult yet continued to scatter an abundance of those seeds of goodness which attracted and won souls to grace. She was one of Our Lady's gifts to the Institute in whom we find the fulfillment of the evangelical message of the works of mercy. She spread the perfume of radiant goodness, her sweet smile and Salesian cheerfulness wherever she passed by and her wise and much sought after counsels pervaded not only the hospital wards but the corridors and the places she visited. In her missionary endeavours, she placed high value on securing the good of souls, preventing offence against God and safeguarding Christian morals. As we celebrate her feast day on 25 August, let us ask her to intercede for us before the Lord and grant us too a share of her missionary ardour and zeal for souls making ever more fruitful our apostolate among the young people.
