Dearest Sisters,

Warm and affectionate greetings to you from the Provincial House, Dum Dum!

I am sure that the past month of June saw every one of you very busy preparing yourselves as communities and individuals for the re-opening of the school and other informal centres of evangelizing education. I am also certain that you have already begun with greater fervor, vigour and enthusiasm the daily apostolic activities, with the awareness that we are all called to be educators of holiness wherever we are and in whatever we do.

Article 1 of our Constitutions tells us clearly: "In an attitude of faith and gratitude to God, and in imitation of St. Mary Domenica Mazzarello, we, Daughters of Mary Help of Christians, give our life to God becoming the sign and expression of his foreseeing love among young people". Therefore, our vocation is first and foremost to bring God's love to the young people especially the poorest. **We are called to be a sign of God's love** for them, to be transparently good and loving so that people can be led to believe in God's love and goodness. When we are such persons, we become a visible and effective sign of God's invisible presence and action.

The Lord who entrusted us with the Evangelizing Educational Mission among the young people, invites us to live our lives with love and to be holy by bearing witness in everything we do, wherever we find ourselves.

Our Mother General in her circular letter 979 which speaks of a renewed life of holiness, reminds us that the **community is a place to walk together in holiness**, that sanctification is a community journey. At Valdocco and Mornese sanctity was at home and there was competition to make the seeds of holiness received in Baptism shine with new light. Our saintly founders were artisans of saints: adults and young people. Mother Mazzarello, for example, in Letter no. 18 tells: "For us religious it is not enough to save only our own soul. We must become holy and through our holy good works, help many others who are waiting for our help to become holy".

Yes, dear Sisters, as we forge ahead in our Educational Mission, let us be convinced that **to walk with young people in holiness of life** is an essential part of our mission and that every young person has the potential to reach it. It is up to us to propose to them, in various ways, a journey of youthful holiness, a holiness found in our "next door" as Pope Francis calls it, that is, a life that reflect God's presence, in the very ordinariness of daily life. He invites us to take

small steps to holiness, that is, to stop talking badly about anyone, to have recourse to Rosary in times of anxiety and to utter a kind word to the one in need and so on (Cf.GE16).

I wish you a very fervent and fruitful continuation of the Evangelizing Education making the "next door" holiness lived in the spirit of the Beatitudes shine in each one of us, in our communities, in the young people and in our environments. May our Blessed Mother and our holy founders walk with us and help us to be holy, enthusiastic, vibrant and active missionaries of hope and joy by fulfilling all our duties with extraordinary love, responsibility, dedication, and creative fidelity!
