The great day has dawned in the history of the FMA world as we commenced the month of August!

150th Foundation Day

August 5th is a day so very dear to all the FMA in the world. It's a day of grace and strong feeling of communion and gratitude. It's the solemn feast for all of us, dear Sisters. On this day we recall with love and gratitude the "Living Monument". The Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians is a monument of perennial gratitude for the singular favours granted by Mary, the Help of Christians. Don Bosco affirms: "You are Daughters – remember this well – not Ladies, not Mothers, not Mistresses, neither Sisters nor Servants.



Daughters! This name is always the sweetest to the ear, the dearest to the heart... Daughters of Mary! Yours is a great glory! Jesus is Mary's Son and you are made equal to Him'.

Joy for the gift of our vocation as a call of predilection has its culmination in the celebration of 5th August, the jubilee feast of our Institute. The renewal of the Covenant of love with God is an ulterior sign that our life is an uninterrupted hymn of praise to the Father's mercy, marked by the effort to live the beatitudes as we say in the formula of the vows: "In response to Your love, I commit myself to live the Beatitudes of the Kingdom radically in communion with my sisters, proclaiming Christ to the young."

"You have renounced everything, but there still remains to you the most beautiful and precious treasure on earth and in heaven: Mary, the apple of God's eye! Comfort yourselves in your troubles and difficulties; you are confided to the care of this divine Mother who watches over you with infinite tenderness. Endeavour at all cost to be a true Daughter of Mary Help of Christians."

The Obligation of our Title

Being a Daughter of Mary Help of Christians obliges us to live with Mary and through Mary. Reproducing in ourselves her spiritual likeness as a daughter reproduces the likeness of the mother. The greatest form of imitating Her is by living the virtues of Our Lady: her immaculate purity, her profound humility, her heroic spirit of sacrifice and especially her active goodness. This Marian character of our way of acting and working is an obligation imposed by our vocation, stemming from the fact that we form part of a Congregation that is Marian.

The celebration of 5th August is an occasion for us to increase our love for Our Lady. Don Bosco chose Main and her companions so that they would live an intense love for Mary. Where Mary is, there is the future and Don Bosco points to the future. At Mornese, as at Nizza, the Madonna is not a guest; She is the owner of the house as She is today in each of our educating communities. We celebrate because we are happy for having given our life to God at the service of the littlest ones and the poorest. We celebrate because "a festive heart is a heart that loves the Lord very much" as Mother Mazzarello would say.

Evangelical and Charismatic Force

The time of jubilee is an opportune moment to return to the evangelical and charismatic sources, to rediscover the Spirit of our Holy Founders and go deeply into our Origins, in order to reshape our own very lives, communities and mission. It is an event of grace in which we can rediscover with greater depth the roots of our call. Let us live the solemn feast of 5th August by remembering the history that God has woven with each of us, making us aware that we are called to narrate it and accomplish it, day after day, in the certainty that each one is responsible so that history may be more original and rich in newness. It is a history to live as protagonists, with and for the young; to contagion with our testimony of joyful fidelity.

Triumph of the Blessed Virgin Mary

As a Family that belongs totally to Mary, we rejoice and celebrate the Triumph of Mary our Mother on 15th August. In 1950, Pope Pius XII declared the Assumption of Mary as official dogma of the Roman Catholic Church which teaches that the Virgin Mary "having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." By using the image "assumed body and soul into heaven" what is really being said is that Mary, because of the dignity of her motherhood and her own personal submission to God's will at every stage of her life, takes precedence over everyone in the sharing of God's glory which is the destiny of all of us who die united with Christ her Son.

The feast of the Assumption fills us with hope because it anticipates the final victory of God over evil, violence and death. In the power of the life, death and resurrection of Christ,



we partake of God's love, which is stronger than death. As we honour the Assumption of Mary, let us give thanks for her maternal care and protection. Mary has cared and protected us, all through the 150 years of our Institute, through all changes and upheavals. Therefore, we cannot simply honour her without following her example of care and protection for others. May Mary then help us to be carers and protectors of those who have been entrusted to us. On this feast of the Assumption let us acknowledge that Mary is closer to us than ever, if only we would welcome her, if only we entrust our lives to God the Father, through Christ, in the Holy Spirit.

May Mary be the guiding light for all of us to live our commitment in its fullness, helping us to be firm and convinced in living the mandate "I entrust them to you", bringing forth life in abundance. Let us ask her to intercede for us her daughters with her Son that we may remain faithful to our renewed commitment and say our unconditional Yes to what God wants for us.
