My dearest Sisters,

Affectionate greetings to you!

We just celebrated the solemnity of our father and founder, teacher and lover of the young, a man with vision and hope and a model of joy and cheerfulness. Celebration of this feast is an invitation and bidding for all of us to imitate him in our mission for the young. The decision of Don Bosco to live and work for the young can be summarized in his own words: "I have promised God that until my last breath I shall live for my poor young people. I study for you, I work for you, I am also ready to give my life for you. Whatever I am; I have been so entirely for you, day and night, morning and evening, at every moment." So, it is most certain that Don Bosco is alive today, alive in so many different realities where thousands and thousands of people carry his dream forward. And he is still alive because he continues to be our inspiration.

Don Bosco was an everyday saint, attained sanctity in the ordinariness of life. He found his strength and courage to go ahead with his plans and projects in spite of the hurdles and hitches that he encountered almost every day of his life. It was his faith, hope and charity that led him to make the impossibility into possibility. It was his deep rootedness in prayer that gave him strength and courage to face stark reality of life. Don Bosco was able to find God in the Holy Eucharist and his great devotion to Mary Help of Christians. When we unfold the pages of his life we see how much influence Our Lady had in his life from the very beginning of his earthly life. After John Bosco donned the clerical habit when he was preparing himself to go to the Seminary of Chieri Mamma Margaret, approached John and said: "When you were born I consecrated you to the Madonna, when you started your studies I advised you to have a tender devotion to this Mother" and John treasured this devotion until the end of his life. Don Bosco's gigantic work started with a simple "Hail Mary" and later on he himself would say 'Our congregation is led by Mary Most Holy."

Our Constitutions Article 4 invites us to live this devotion to Mary Most holy: 'Let us be aware of Mary's presence in our lives and entrust ourselves entirely to her. We strive to make her disposition of faith, hope and charity, and her perfect union with Christ, our own. Let us open our hearts to the joyous humility of her magnificat to be helpers, like her, especially among the young people". Again Article 44 of our Constitutions summons us to honor Mary Most holy by celebrating the liturgical feasts and honoring her daily by the devout recitation of the Rosary.

Mother Chiara Cazzuola, the Grand Chancellor of the Pontifical Faculty of Educational

Sciences "Auxilium" Rome: Mother Chiara Cazzuola, the Superior General of our Institute is henceforth Grand Chancellor of the Pontifical Faculty of Educational Sciences "Auxilium" in Rome. The Holy Father Francis approved the proposal in the audience granted to the Excellent Substitute for General Affairs of the Secretariat of State, Archbishop Edgar Peña Parra, on 2 November 2021. It is an important landmark in the 52 years of the faculty's life. Since 1970, when the International Higher Institute of Pedagogy and Religious Sciences of the Institute of the



Daughters of Mary Help of Christians, founded in 1954, aggregated in 1964, and then incorporated in 1966 to the Higher Institute of Pedagogy of the Salesian Pontifical Athenaeum, became the first Pontifical Faculty entrusted to a female religious institute. The Grand Chancellor was the Rector Major of the Salesian Society of St. John Bosco. The Vice Grand Chancellor was the Superior General of the Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians. United with the entire Institute let us praise and thank God for this gift and pray for our dear Mother General so that she may be filled with gift of wisdom to give new impetus and vitality to the faculty.
