Month of the Holy Rosary

We are in the month of October and in the Catholic world, this month is known as the month of the Holy Rosary. The Holy Rosary is one of the devotions that honor Mary more profoundly than most other devotions. Pope Benedict XVI, giving his reflection on the Rosary, invited the faithful to experience personally the beauty and depth of this prayer which is simple and accessible to everyone. When we pray the Rosary we contemplate the face of Christ, and we pray the Word of God, thus when we pray the Rosary we remain ever anchored to Scripture and to the mysteries presented in it. The Holy Rosary is considered a perfect prayer



because it consists of the story of our salvation. The centre of this prayer is not Mary, but Jesus. It is so simple but so effective as to receive whatever we ask Jesus through Mary. In every apparition -, the heavenly Mother has asked us to pray the Rosary as a powerful weapon against evil, to bring us true peace and joy. "The greatest method of praying is to pray the Rosary." (Saint Francis de Sales). Let us use this method as much as possible and encourage and teach others to do the same.

Feast of the Guardian Angels

On 02 October we celebrate the feast of the Guardian Angels in the church. An Angel is a pure spirit created by God who glorifies God without ceasing and watches over us during our lives. Guardian angels are first and foremost doing God's will. Our guardian angel is in constant communication with God and intercedes for us on our behalf to the heavenly Father. Their mission is to do whatever they can to protect our souls, help us avoid sin and spiritual dangers

and gain entrance to heaven. Pope Francis said, "The angel is the daily door toward transcendence, to the encounter with the Father. The angel helps me walk along the path because he looks at the Father who knows the way". Therefore, let us pray to our guardian angels, and seek their help and intercession in all our needs.



World Mission Sunday

Pope Francis, for this year's World Mission Sunday, has chosen a theme inspired by the story of the disciples on the way to Emmaus, in the Gospel of Luke (cf. 24:13-35): "Hearts on fire, feet on the move". Holy Father says: "Those two disciples were confused and dismayed, but their encounter with Christ in the word and in the breaking of the bread sparked in them the enthusiastic desire to set out again towards Jerusalem and proclaim that the Lord had truly risen. In the Gospel account, we perceive this change in the disciples through a few revealing images: their hearts burned within them as they heard the Scriptures explained by Jesus, their eyes were opened as they recognized him and, ultimately, their feet set out on the way."

By reading and meditating on these three images, we can and let us renew our zeal for evangelization wherever we are called to in our apostolic ministry. I would like to highlight a few points from the message of our Holy Father.

"Our hearts burned within us when he explained the Scriptures to us". In missionary activity, the word of God illumines and transforms hearts. So let us always be willing to let ourselves be accompanied by the Risen Lord as he explains to us the meaning of the Scriptures. May he make our hearts burn within us; may he enlighten and transform us, so that we can proclaim his mystery of salvation to the world with the power and wisdom that come from his Spirit.

Our eyes were "opened and recognized him" in the breaking of the bread. Jesus in the Eucharist is the source and summit of the mission. This union is achieved through daily prayer, particularly in Eucharistic adoration, as we remain in silence in the presence of the Lord, who remains with us in the Blessed Sacrament. By lovingly cultivating this communion with Christ, the missionary disciple can become a mystic in action. May our hearts always yearn for the company of Jesus, echoing the ardent plea of the two disciples of Emmaus, especially in the evening hours: "Stay with us, Lord!" (cf. Lk 24:29).

After their eyes were opened and they recognized Jesus "in the breaking of the bread", the disciples "set out without delay and returned to Jerusalem" (cf. Lk 24:33). So let us set out once more, illumined by our encounter with the risen Lord and prompted by his Spirit. Let us set out again with burning hearts, with our eyes open and our feet in motion. Let us set out to make other hearts burn with the word of God, to open the eyes of others to Jesus in the Eucharist, and to invite everyone to walk together on the path of peace and salvation that God, in Christ, has bestowed upon all humanity.

Dear sisters, let us invite and allow Jesus to journey with us, accompany us and open our eyes so that our hearts may burn for Him and for His mission that is entrusted to us. But before we set out let us sit before the Lord motionless to be a mystic in action.
